

## **President and Executive Director, Mozilla Foundation**

*July 2022*

### *Purpose*

As the President and Executive Director of the Mozilla Foundation, Mark plays a Pan Mozilla leadership role, with specific focus on: sustainability, growth and good governance for Mozilla overall (50%); and, design, growth and impact of Mozilla Foundation's philanthropy and advocacy programs (50%). He also acts as a spokesperson for Mozilla by articulating and promoting our vision and mission.

### **Pan Mozilla Leadership (aka 'apex function')**

- Work with our Boards of Directors to develop and regularly update a long term strategy for Mozilla, with a focus on growing impact and sustainability.
- Grow Mozilla's scope and influence over time, both through the support of existing Mozilla organizations and, from time to time, the creation of new ones.
- Design and lead efforts to communicate Mozilla's big picture story, working marketing and communication teams from across the Mozilla portfolio.
- Lead and coordinate fundraising efforts across a variety of Mozilla organizations, raising funds from foundations, governments, investment partners and the public.
- Develop a strong team of senior Pan Mozilla leaders, housed both within the Foundation and within other Mozilla organizations.

### **Foundation Program Leadership**

- Create and oversee philanthropy and advocacy programs within the Foundation to achieve the overall mission as outlined in the Mozilla Manifesto.
- Develop a team of senior executives to lead and grow Foundation programs, with an eye to expanding influence, funding and impact over time.
- Working with program executives, develop annual goals and budgets for the Foundation's philanthropy and advocacy programs.
- Champion diversity, equity and openness across the Foundation's teams and programs.

*Note: this scope assumes that we uplevel current program execs to have 'GM-like' responsibility for the financial success and impact of their programs.*

### **Board and Community Development**

- Working with the Chair, support the development and functioning of the Foundation Board by developing agendas, facilitating meetings and leading recruitment efforts.
- Facilitate collaboration across the Foundation Board and other Boards in the Mozilla portfolio, especially in relation to topics which impact Mozilla as a whole.
- Provide support for the leaders of new Mozilla organizations (e.g. MZLA, Ventures and .ai), either by serving as a Board member or informally via coaching.
- Regularly convene executive leaders across Mozilla with an eye to developing a strong, well connected bench of leaders to support our long term success.
- Ensure that a strong cadre of volunteers and community members are integrated into the organization, culture and leadership of Mozilla.
